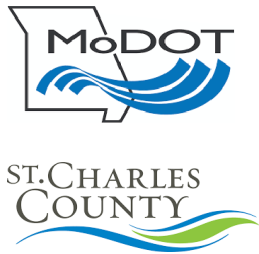

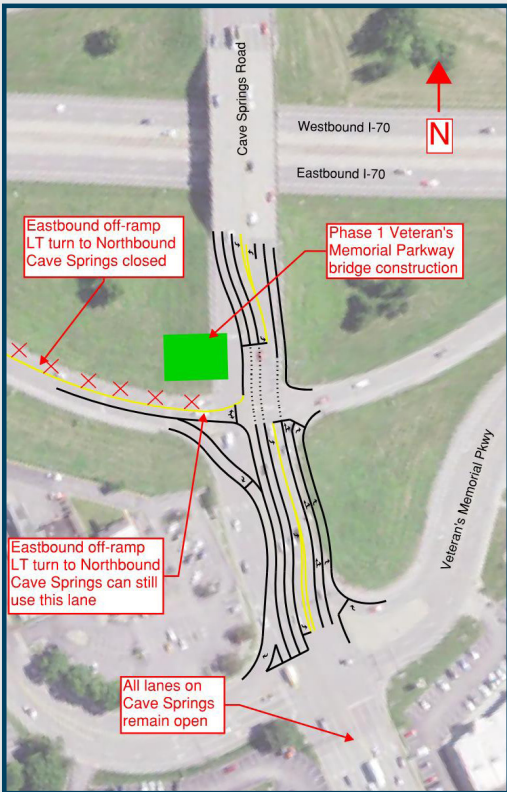
CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

In preparation for an upcoming traffic shift on Cave Springs, crews will be installing a temporary traffic signal at the eastbound I-70 ramps. This work will require one lane on northbound Cave Springs over I-70 to be closed between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. starting on Wednesday, August 31. The work will continue for a week. All work is weather permitting.

« The traffic shift on Cave Springs over I-70 will be happening in mid-September. All lanes of Cave Springs will remain open, but the shift allows crews to construct the new structure that will take Veterans Memorial Parkway under Cave Springs.

In addition to the traffic shift, one of the two left turn lanes from eastbound I-70 to northbound Cave Springs will be closed. Motorists will still be able to make a left turn from the remaining turn lane.

More information will be released once a date has been identified. The traffic shift and exit lane closure will remain in place until spring 2023.

NAVIGATING THE WORKZONE

Daily lane closures continue on I-70 at Zumbuhl and Cave Springs. Crews are building the footings and columns for the new overpass at Zumbuhl and in the next few weeks will begin building the walls.

We also have reduced the speed limit to 50 mph to keep both you and our workers safe. Please use caution when traveling the corridor!



WHAT YOU MIGHT BE SEEING

Crews will continue driving pile in early September for the new overpass at Cave Springs. That will last a couple weeks and then work will start on the footings and columns.
