CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

As we move out of winter and into spring, construction work on the I-70 Cave Springs Design-Build project will kick into overdrive. Over the next couple months, crews will be working to finish work on the first half of the new Zumbehl overpass and move traffic onto the new structure. Crews will also be pouring the bridge deck at Cave Springs and constructing the walls at Veterans Memorial Parkway to set the pre-cast Arch structure in place at Cave Springs.

SAFETY SPOTLIGHT

One of the most important things motorists can do is to make sure they leave adequate braking room between your vehicle and the one ahead of you. Don't tailgate! Count out at least two seconds from the time the car ahead of you passes an object and the time your own car passes that object.

If you're the one being tailgated, don't force tailgaters to back off by slamming on your brakes or reducing your speed significantly. This can increase the chances of a collision. When possible, pull over and let them pass.
