3.5 & 4.3	<p>In section 4.3, Page Limits, (Part 3 – Key Personnel Experience) it states there are (3) pages allowed for Key Tasks in addition to the (3) pages allowed for the Executive Summary. In Part 3 – Key Personnel and Organization submittal requirements (Page 10 of 17 of the RFQ) there is no mention of the three pages and expected detail for the Key Tasks. Please confirm the maximum number of pages for Part 3 and, if the total is (6) pages, the submittal requirements of the Key Tasks section.</p>	<p>The three (3) pages allowed for the key tasks were intended to be in addition to the three (3) pages allowed for the executive summary. The key tasks are identified based on the project’s needs and may not be addressed by the required key personnel listed in section 3.5. The intent is to provide an opportunity for each Submitter to share their approach to managing the key tasks that they identify as being critical for the success of the project. An addendum will be issued to allow for a six (6) page executive summary that includes the key tasks.</p>	Yes
	<p>Will MoDOT provide RFP scoring criteria, even if in draft form, to allow proposer to best determine Key Personnel and Additional Key Personnel?</p>	<p>MoDOT will not have the scoring criteria released prior to submittal of the Statement of Qualifications. However, MoDOT intends to release a draft copy of the Request for Proposal scoring criteria, in the form of a draft Instructions to Proposer, prior to the release of the Request for Proposals.</p>	No
	<p>RFQ item 3.3 Part 1 Administrative Elements notes that Form DB-802 Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility, and Voluntary Exclusion is required to be executed and submitted; however, the 1/2017 revision date on the form posted with the July 19 revised RFQ is earlier than the 4/2019 version posted with the December 7, 2020 RFQ. Since the posted Forms DB-102, DB-104 and DB-105 have newer revision dates (5/2021 and 6/2021, respectively), please confirm that proposers should use the newer 4/2019 version of DB-802 for their SOQ submittals.</p>	<p>Proposers are instructed to use the DB-802 (1/2017) form on the I-70 CSFG website.</p>	No

Please confirm that proposers need to submit executed Form DB-110s for each Key Personnel and for the two additional personnel as part of their Part 3 Key Personnel and Organization response.</p>	<p>Proposers are instructed to use the DB-110 Commitment of Key Personnel for each Key Personnel. Please confirm that proposers should provide their Key Task approach discussion as part of their Part 3 response and that the discussion is limited to 3 pages, which are in addition to the 3-page Executive Summary also required.</p>	<p>The three (3) pages allowed for the key tasks were intended to be in addition to the three (3) pages allowed for the executive summary. The key tasks are identified based on the project's needs and may not be addressed by the required key personnel listed in section 3.5. The intent is to provide an opportunity for each Submitter to share their approach to managing the key tasks that they identify as being critical for the success of the project. Addendum 1 was issued to allow for a six (6) page executive summary that includes the key tasks.</p>	No
	<p>During the Industry meeting presentation, it was stated that a traffic model was developed for a solution with two-way outer roads and that items for possible future release included traffic models and draft CE2 and/or AJR. During the Q&A portion of the presentation, it was stated that the preliminary design in the draft AJR was the conceptual study layout that was provided in the early release information. Is a conceptual strip map of the two-way layout outer road solution that reflects the solution in the two-way traffic model available for teams to review? Can this be included within an upcoming package of early release information?</p>	<p>MoDOT does not intend on releasing any further draft strip maps before the release of the Request for Proposals.</p>	No
	<p>Will MoDOT make available an additional early release package and a Draft RFP as soon as possible?</p>	<p>MoDOT intends to make available additional early release information before the Request for Proposals.
